When talking with religious people, helping them see God's grace is more important than convincing them that you are right.

Religious People

1. When you are confident in what you have to say, you don't have to control the circumstances in which you say it
2. You don't have to shame someone for their beliefs to share with them what Jesus offers
3. While others rest in who they are and what they have achieved, keep emphasizing Who God is and what He will do
4. Spend less time theorizing about God and heaven and more time personalizing what new birth means
5. Your conversation may leave people more confused than convinced, but that might be right where God wants them to be
